SAT AND ACT

SAT Juniors 11th Graders will be registered by the school to take the SAT on 4/9 - As of this posting the exam is scheduled to be in school. You will be informed if there is a change.

COLLEGE OFFICE APPOINTMENTS

In order to assist you with making a balanced list of colleges to apply to, you will need to make an appointment with the College Office.

1. Complete the 11th Grade College Survey and the Parent Survey no later than 2 days before your meeting.
2. Once you have COMPLETED, the surveys, you must respond to the letter that was sent to you by your college counselor. In the letter, you will receive a link to make your College Office appointment.
3. You should schedule your appointment for no later than **Monday, March 17th**. (Appointments will go through May, but you need to SCHEDULE it by March 6th.)
4. Make sure that your appointments are scheduled during your: Non-academic classes with **2 days** advance notice to your teacher. This is your responsibility. Please make sure you give at least **1 day's** notice if you are unable to attend
5. Remember that these are family meetings. So please remember to communicate with your family member/s when scheduling your meeting. They are welcome to join us in person for

your meeting. However, we can provide a virtual option if necessary.

HOW DO I REGISTER FOR AN SAT/ACT FEE WAIVER?

You must comply with the following:

1. You completed your lunch form
2. You are eligible for free and/or reduced lunch
3. Go to your college counselor to receive your fee waiver Code

Once the above steps apply to you, you will be eligible to receive your full set of fee waiver benefits online and will automatically have access to all the benefits. You will not need to enter this code again.
